MOULD IN HOUSING HOW TO CLEAN UP MOULD IN YOUR HOME


Mould should be removed as soon as possible. Here are some ways that you can find and fix affected areas.

FIVE STEPS TO REMOVING MOULD FROM YOUR HOME

- FIND, STOP AND FIX THE SOURCE OF THE MOISTURE PROBLEM
- REMOVE ALL WET OR DAMAGED MATERIALS
- CLEAN UP THE MOULD
- PREVENT EXPOSURE TO MOULD AND DEBRIS
- RESTORE OR RENOVATE THE CLEANED UP AREA



- Has less than three patches.
- One square metre in size each.
- Can clean it yourself if you are in good health.
- Clean using water and unscented dishwashing detergent.





- Has more than three patches.
- Total area is smaller than three square metres.
- Should be cleaned up by qualified and trained maintenance staff.





- Total area covers more than three square metres.
- Large patches throughout the home.
- Should be cleaned up by qualified and trained mould remediation contractors.
