

What is the On-Reserve Residential Rehabilitation Assistance Program (RRAP)?

The On-Reserve Residential Rehabilitation Assistance Program (RRAP) provides financial assistance to First Nations and First Nation members to cover the costs of major repairs and adaptations for their homes.

Who is eligible?

This program is open to all First Nations or individual First Nation members. The occupants' total household income must be at or below the established limit which is based on the location of the community.

What work is eligible?

The house must lack basic facilities or is in need of major repairs or adaptations in one or more of the following categories:

- Structural
- Electrical
- Plumbing
- 1 Iuiiibiiig
- Heating (HVAC)
- · Fire safety

with Disabilities, or minor adaptations for Seniors, the maximum

amount may be increased by 25%

Repairs will only be eligible for funding if the work started after you submitted your application. Once you get approval, all work must start within 3 months and be completed within 12 months.

What assistance is available?

The maximum loan amount is \$60,000* per unit.

The financial assistance is in the form of a contribution.

* If your property is located on-reserve in northern or remote

areas, or the project includes accessibility work for Persons
