
Matawa First Nations. Regional Decision Making Framework

Each session convened fifty leaders from a diverse range of sectors and backgrounds—including education, business—to imagine how to better work together in pursuit of a shared and sustainable future.

Using a collaborative design and strategic foresight toolkit, these sessions combined speaker addresses, guided breakout activities, and plenary discussions to enable uncommon, interdisciplinary, and generative thinking.



Coeuraj is currently contracted by Matawa First Nations Management in Northwest Ontario to facilitate a multi-year collaborative design process to develop a Regional Decision-Making Framework between the nine First Nations Matawa represents. Phase one was completed in May of 2018, and Phase two is active. Coeuraj has delivered planning meetings, facilitated collaborative engagements and capacity training within community, provided processes to co-create project governance structures, and has performed research, analysis, communications and strategic planning.

The outcomes of such activities strengthened alignment between Nations and their commitment to work together, and produced community decision-making models authored by each of the nine Nations to inform the Regional Decision-Making Framework under way.
